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### EIGHT ATTRIBUTES OF THE GOD – எண்குணத்தான்

- 1. Omnipotent: All powerful
- 2. Omniscient: Knows everything
- 3. By nature, God knows everything, (not by education or by experience)
- 4. By nature, free from any taints/ fetters
- 5. Pure embodiment (pure form)
- 6. Independent, never dependent on anything
- 7. Infinite unconditional unlimited Love (AruL)
- 8. Infinite Bliss

#### THREE ATTRIBUTES OF THE GOD

- 1. Volitional potency *Ichcha Sakti*, the reason for will
- 2. Cognitive potency *Jnana Sakti*, the reason for knowledge
- 3. Conative potency Kriya Sakti, the reason for action

MURUGAN'S vel represents *Jnana Sakti*, the cognitive potency;

VALLI represents *Ichcha Sakti*, the volitional potency and

THEIVANAI represents *Kriya Sakti*, the conative potency

God has unlimited potencies mentioned above.

Soul also has these potencies but veiled, restricted and restrained by the engulfing fetter *Anava*.

The veiling Anava is weakened with the maturing intelligence of the individual soul when it gains knowledge and experience through multitudes of births as per its individual karmic deeds.

Once the intelligence of the individual souls matures to the ripened stage, God's grace will bestow *Mukti* to the soul by eliminating the power of the prime fetter Anava altogether.

At this state of liberation, above mentioned three unlimited potencies of the God directly synchronize with the corresponding three potencies of the soul. Thus, the potencies of the liberated soul become unlimited.

Soul in this liberated state of Mukti, enjoys the state of *Sivatuvam* - God-hood endlessly.

This state of non-dual union of our individual soul with the God is called *Advaita Mukti*.

Dwaita – means dual/two. Advaita – means non-dual. Mukti – means – ultimate final release from all the restrictions/bondages/darkness/sufferings/cycles of births and deaths.

### TWO ATTRIBUTES OF THE GOD AS SIVA and SAKTHI

- 1. Jnana (Knowledge) as Sivam
- 2. AruL (Love) as Sakthi

We need full of these two for our perfection but limited by our binding triple fetters of Anava, karma and maya.

When our binding fetters goes away in our liberated state of Mukti, we become the embodiments of Jnana, the knowledge and AruL, the Love for ever.

- 1. Masculinity as Sivam
- 2. Femininity as Sakthi

Polarity in the insentient energy and matter in this world as Sivam and Sakthi

- 1. Positive/ Negative (Electronic)
- 2. Proton/ Electron (Atom)
- 3. Cathode/ Anode (Electricity)
- 4. North pole/South pole (Magnetic)
- 5. Centripetal / Centrifugal (Gravity)
