SIVA-JNĀNA -BŌDHA, SŪTRA 10

- The soul inseparable with its triple fetters of \bar{A} nava, karma and $m\bar{a}y\bar{a}$ in its bound state does not know the inseparable God with him/her.
- Similarly, the soul **in inseparable union** with **the** God in **its** realized state of **mukti** does not know itself separately.
- In this state of advaita non-dual union, the soul does all its actions as of His, and is no longer entangled by the triple fetters.

This tenth Sūtra of Siva-Jnāna -Bōdha is explained in Siva- Jnāna- Siddiyār Songs 304 to 309.
