SIVA-JNĀNA -BŌDHA, SŪTRA 3

- The one rejects the existence of the soul;
- The one claims this as my body;
- The one is conscious of dreams when awake;
- The one exists without any actions or experience in sound sleep;
- The one knows through the five senses is the soul;
- which is within this body-mind-sense complex
- made of tatwas, the evolutes
- from māyā, the material cause of everything.

Note: Material cause provides the necessary constituent material(s) and energy for the causal chain. $M\bar{a}ya$, one of the triple fetters is the material cause for everything except soul(s) and the God. $M\bar{a}ya$ constitutes,

- 1. our bodies,
- 2. instruments of bodies including psychic faculties,
- 3. Cosmic worlds and
- 4. the objects in the world(s) for our experience.

This third Sūtra of Siva-Jnāna -Bōdha is explained in Siva- Jnāna- Siddiyār Songs 186 to 189.
