SIVA-JNĀNA -BŌDHA, SŪTRA 5

- The five sensory organs- skin, mouth, eyes, nose (and ears)- know distinctly their respective objects of perception by the soul, not by themselves.
- While doing so, they know neither themselves nor the soul.
- Similarly, the soul cognizes and experiences by the God, but it knows neither itself nor the God.
- When the soul is moved to realize this by **Siva's** Grace, **Siva** is unaffected anyway, like the magnet that draws iron filings.

This fifth Sūtra of Siva-Jnāna -Bōdha is explained in Siva- Jnāna- Siddiyār Songs 231 to 239.
