

SIVA-JNĀNA -BŌDHA, SŪTRA 6

- *If God is a perceptible object, then He would be a nescient matter - **asat**;*
- *If God is imperceptible, then God would be an unreal non-existence.*
- *God is neither perceptible nor imperceptible but both as spiritual reality - **siva-sat**;*
- *Which is imperceptible by mundane and or spiritual intelligence but*
- *Perceptible only by the supreme intelligence **siva-jnāna**, conferred by Him,*
- *say the wise.*

This sixth Sūtra of Siva-Jnāna -Bōdha is explained in Siva- Jnāna- Siddiyār Songs 240 to 248.
