SIVA-JNĀNA -BŌDHA, SŪTRA 6

- If God is a perceptible object, then He would be a nescient matter asat;
- If God is imperceptible, then God would be an unreal non-existence.
- God is neither perceptible nor imperceptible but both as spiritual reality siva-sat;
- Which is imperceptible by mundane and or spiritual intelligence but
- Perceptible only by the supreme intelligence siva-jnāna, conferred by Him,
- say the wise.

This sixth Sūtra of Siva-Jnāna -Bōdha is explained in Siva- Jnāna- Siddiyār Songs 240 to 248.
