SIVA-JNĀNA -BŌDHA, SŪTRA 7

- The world is an **asat**, as such it is nescient, ever changing and impermanent;
- Thus, it does not know or experience the **sat**, the God, who is, ever permanent, never changing Omniscient being.
- The Omniscient God does not need to know or experience **asat**, the nescient world.
- The one that knows and experiences both the Omniscient sat God and the nescient asat- the world is the parviscient soul -sat-asat.

This seventh Sūtra of Siva-Jnāna -Bōdha is explained in Siva- Jnāna- Siddiyār Songs 249 to 252.
