SIVA-JNĀNA -BŌDHA, SŪTRA 9

Perceiving the Lord, who cannot be perceived by the gross intellect and senses, but by **siva- jnāna**, the supreme intelligence conferred, the soul disentangles itself from the fleeting mirage of material attachments and rests blissfully under the cooling shade of **siva anubhūdi**- joyfull experience of **Siva** and meditates upon **panjākshara**- the five syllable **mantrā**- as ordained.

This ninth Sūtra of Siva-Jnāna - Bōdha is explained in Siva- Jnāna- Siddiyār Songs 292 to 303.
